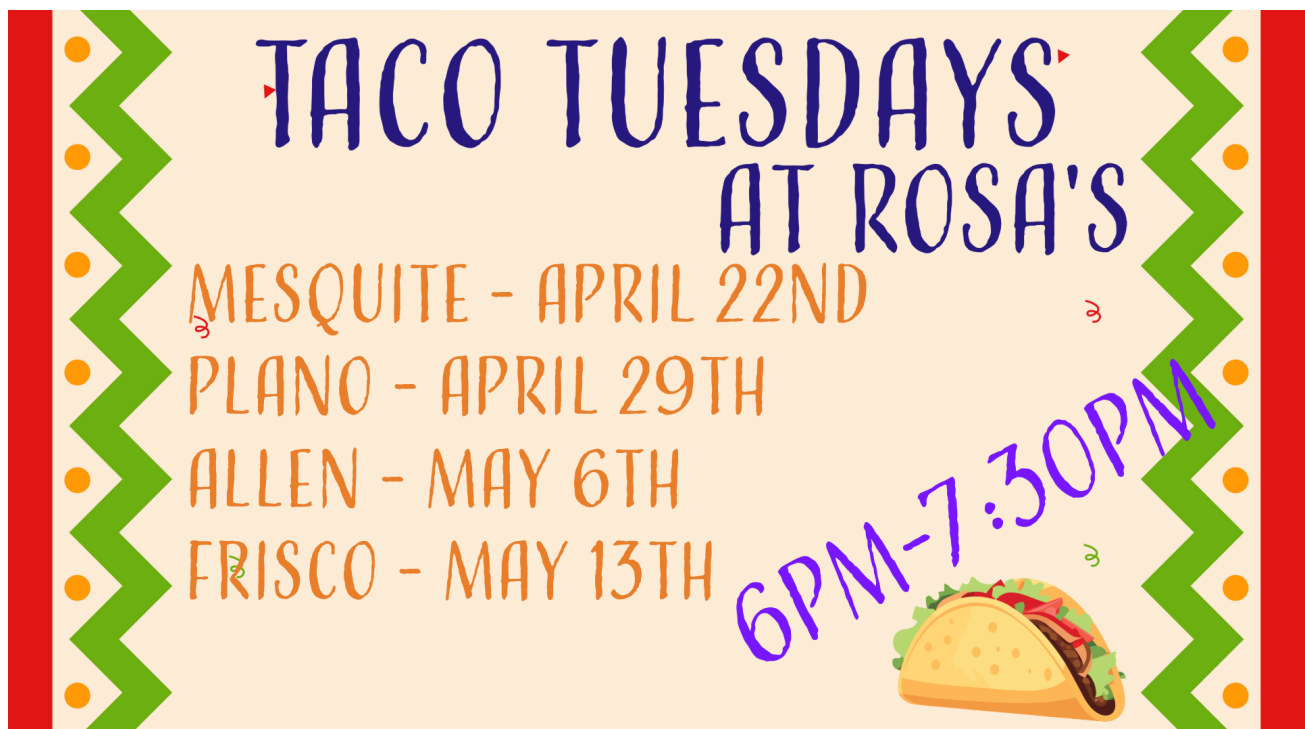
Ladies Fibers & Fellowship Crochet Group

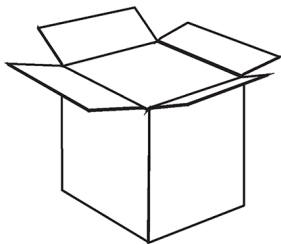
